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SCHOOL GOALS

Goal 1: Literacy

By the end of SY 2023-2024, Garmisch Elementary Middle School will strengthen implementation of College and Career readiness for all students by ensuring all classrooms teaching Literacy skills reflect standards-based instruction as measured by performance on the DoDEA CCR Summative Assessment by a 5% increase (over baseline) yearly of students "meeting or exceeding expectations" and decrease by 3% students in the did not meet or partially met performance levels on SY 21-22 assessment and ORR in grades K-3.

Goal 2: Math

By the end of SY 2023-2024, grades 3-8 & Algebra 1 will increase by 5% students in the met or exceeded performance levels by and decrease by 3% students in the did not meet or partially met performance levels over two years as reported on the systemwide CCRSM Summative Assessment.

 - All students should have high expectations and be supported so they can achieve academic and social excellence.


